- ◆ Over 240 guarantees and incentives for investors, including 110 tax and customs benefits
- ◆ 5 Special Economic Zones with tax exemptions; lease rates from \$1/m² per year
- ◆ Law on Investments guarantees equal rights for domestic and foreign investors
- ◆ State Investment Program 2026–2030 totaling \$15.7 billion
- ◆ 98% of electricity from renewable sources (hydropower)
- ◆ Strategic location providing access to Central Asian, Chinese, and South Asian markets
